



General Instructions

1. **ONLINE PAYMENT OF APPLICATION FEE AND SUBMISSION OF FILLED IN APPLICATIONS:**
 - i. Application Fee ₹1000/- and ₹ 300/- (portal charges fee non-refundable) for UR & OBC Category and no application fee but only ₹ 300/- (portal charges fee non-refundable) for SC/ST/PWD (Divyang) Candidates.
 - ii. Payment shall be made through online portal only.
2. Applicants are advised to submit online applications against each post to the Institute well in advance, without waiting for the last date.
3. The candidates desire to be considered for the post at Gwalior as well as NERC, Guwahati, will be required to submit applications separately.
4. The qualifications, experience, upper age-limit etc. is in accordance with the provisions of LNIPE SBCSR, and LNIPE Service (Recruitment) Rules (Revised as per UGC/DoPT time to time), which are available on the Institute's web-site www.lnipe.edu.in.
5. The Institute may offer lower post to a candidate, who may have applied for a higher post, in case the Selection Committee recommends so.
6. The prescribed qualifications and experience are minimum and the mere fact that a candidate possesses the same will not entitle him/her for being called for interview. The Institute reserves the right to restrict the candidates to be called for interview to a reasonable number on the basis of academic score which may be higher than the minimum prescribed as decided by duly constituted Screening Committee/s and approved by the Competent Authority. Call letters for attending interview will be sent only to the short-listed candidates by Speed Post/Registered Post/Courier service/e-mail. No correspondence will be made with applicants who have not been shortlisted/not called for interview.
7. In case the Institute receives large number of applications for a particular post, the Institute in such cases reserves the right to adopt stringent criteria for shortlisting candidates to be called for interview either by conducting a written test or adopting a marking system as approved by Competent Authority.
8. a) Reservations for SC, ST, OBC and Persons with Disabilities will be as per Government of India norms as amended from time to time. Candidates applying for the Reserved Posts should clearly state to which category they belong. They must also enclose a Certificate issued by Tahsildar/Mandal Revenue Officer/ Equivalent authority as proof to this effect, without which the applications will not be considered.

The form of Caste Certificate must be in the format as prescribed by the Govt. of India; otherwise the application will be summarily rejected without further consideration.
d) Reservation guidelines of Govt. of India, if revised in future shall be applicable & implemented accordingly.
9. The Institute reserves the right to relax any of the qualifications, experience, etc., in deserving cases in respect of any post. Candidates shall not claim it as a right.
10. (i) The Institute may also include the details with regard to anticipated vacancies arising due to retirement/resignation of employee/s of that particular year which shall be filled through the instant advertisement. The Institute reserves the right to fill or not to fill up or to increase or decrease the posts advertised for any reasons whatsoever.


(iv) If any advertisement for any post is withdrawn by the Institute, the application fee collected from the candidates shall be refunded.

(v) Qualifications/ Experiences/ Age etc. as on closing date of advertisement will only be taken into consideration.

11. Selection will be made on the basis of candidates' previous record and their performance in the interview. The Institute may utilize seminar /colloquium/Lecture and/or any other mode as a supplementary method in selection process
12. After submitting online form, Applicants who are already in service shall submit his/her application through proper channel, in case his/her application is not forwarded due to whatever reasons till the time of written test or interview as the case may be, he/she should produce a 'NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE' obtained from his/her employer in a sealed cover from the employer failing which he/she shall not be allowed to appear in the test/interview as the case may be.
13. Those who have joined / are joining the University service on or after 1st January, 2004 are covered under new pension scheme introduced by the Government of India (Central Government). For those appointed on deputation, the term of deputation shall be governed by Government of India rules.
14. The Institute also reserves the right to select candidates with higher qualifications than what is specified or those with different specialization.
15. No application of probationer for employment in other institution shall be forwarded.
16. Canvassing in any form on behalf of any candidate shall be treated as a disqualification which shall lead to cancellation of candidature.
17. Candidates should carefully read teaching/research requirements of the relevant discipline and apply only if they have requisite qualifications and experience. However, those who do not meet the academic standards and requirements should not apply for the sake of applying.
18. The candidates selected for appointment are expected to join at the earliest.
19. A candidate belonging to any reserved category who desires to be considered for any Unreserved post also besides the posts under reserved category, will have to submit separate forms for Unreserved posts with requisite application fee.
20. In case of any inadvertent mistake in the process of selection which may be detected at any stage even after the issuance of appointment letter, the Institute reserves right to modify/withdraw/cancel any communication made to the candidate.
21. In case of any dispute/ambiguity that may arise due to incomplete applications and those received after the closing date shall be summarily rejected without making any reference to the candidates.
