TENDER DOCUMENT-CUM-FORM FOR
REPLACEMENT OF BASKETBALL COURT FLOORING (4 NOS.) AT LNIPE , GWALIOR

(A) ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

The bidding agencies are required to submit the technical bid in the format given at **Annexure 'A'**, along with copies of following documents, duly signed/self-attested, with the technical bid for being declared to be eligible:-

1. EMD of Rs. 90,000/- in the form of Demand Draft in favour of "Registrar, LNIPE" payable at Gwalior or Bank Guarantee from a schedule bank.
2. Certificate of incorporation of the bidder (enclose its copy).
3. GST Registration Number (enclose its copy with the last one month GST Return).
4. Income Tax Permanent Account Number (PAN) (enclose its copy).
5. The average Annual financial turnover during the last 3 years, ending 31st March 2022 (Assessment Year 2021-22), should be at least 30% of the estimated cost (enclose (furnish "Certificate of Turnover" issued by a Chartered Accountant in the format prescribed at **Annexure – 'C'**, along with balance sheets of these three years along with Income Tax Returns).
6. Experience of having successfully completed the similar work during preceding 7 years (up to May 2022) in Government Department / Organizations / PSUs / Educational Institutions / Private Organizations by either of the following:-
 - a) Three similar completed works each costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the estimated cost.
 - b) Two similar completed works each costing not less than the amount equal to 50% of the estimated cost.
 - c) One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to 80% of the estimated cost.

[Enclose copies of only these 3/2/1 work order(s) along with respective completion certificate(s)].

7. The bidder has its own bank account (Detail of account along with statement of last one month to be furnished).
8. A declaration to the following effect is required to be submitted on affidavit on non-judicial stamp of Rs. 100/- that
 - (a) There is no pending criminal case before any Court of law against the Proprietor / firm / Partner or the bidder company;
 - (b) The bidder has not defaulted from the payment of statutory dues like EPF, ESI, GST, Income Tax etc. during the last three years;
 - (c) The bidder is not blacklisted by any Government Organization/PSU/Autonomous Body/ Govt. Educational Institute/Private Organizations during the last three years;

(d) No agreement of the bidder has been terminated before expiry of term during the last three years.

(B) FINANCIAL BID:

- 1 Financial bid is required to be submitted in the format at **Annexure 'B'** .
- 2 Financial bid of only technically qualified bidders will be opened at scheduled date & time, to be intimated separately to such bidders.
- 3 The rates quoted should be inclusive of all taxes. Nothing additional shall be payable during the period of agreement.

(C) SCOPE OF WORK:

1. Firstly, Removing work in synthetic surface in existing Basketball court manually / by mechanical means including disposal of removable material within 1.50 km lead as per direction of Institute .
2. After removing the synthetic material in existing court, firstly Roughing the Surface of the Court and opening the cracks in 'V' groove (size of 10mmX10mm) (WXD), scrubbing with a steel wire/nylon brush and the groove with an air compressor to clean up Wash off with enough water to remove all dust particles and thoroughly clean and fill cracks by Smart Care Crack Seal.
3. Providing and laying of fiber glass mesh (thickness 50 micron) of weaving size of 10x10 per square inches by adhesive solution and fill the fiber mesh by acrylic binder as per specification.
4. Providing and laying synthetic cushioned acrylic surfacing system of International level (Outdoor) duly approved by ITF European make of classification-III, manufactured by company of International repute with minimum Three years warranty with following nine layers of synthetic cushioned surfacing material including marking of court lines with 100% acrylic resin based line marking paint.
 - a) Filler course (One layer) of acrylic resurface.
 - b) Heavy rubber course (Three layers of flexible latex base liquid rubber with course particles.
 - c) Fine rubber course (Two layers of flexible latex base liquid rubber with finer particles.
 - d) Texture Course (One layer of flexible filler acrylic base).
 - e) Finish course (Two layer of 100% acrylic resin base paint. All above application are to be applied as per manufacturing specification/ consumption standards and as per the direction Institute.

Note: 1. Prior to start of above item, the agency shall submit methodology of execution of item for approval of Institue.

2. The rate of above item, includes the cost of material, all statutory taxes, import duty, insurances, labour, tools.

(D) PROCEDURE OF TENDER SUBMISSION:

1. Tenders are required to be submitted in a main sealed envelope super scribed as **“Replacement of Basketball Court Flooring (4 Nos.) at LNIPE , Gwalior”** and it has to be dropped in the tender box kept in the office of Deputy Registrar (Estate) by **3.00 PM** on **18.07.2022**. The same can also be sent by speed post / registered post by clearly mentioning

the above subject on the envelope, and in such cases, it would be responsibility of the bidder that the same is reached to the Institute by **3:00 PM on 18.07.2022**.

2. The main tender envelope should contain two sealed envelopes as under:-

Envelope No. 1 - Containing dully filled in "**Technical Bid**" as per **Annexure 'A'** along with required documents and EMD.

Envelope No. 2 - Containing dully filled in "**Financial Bid**" as per **Annexure 'B'** rate/amount to be given in numerals as well as in words in the space provided for the purpose and write "**Financial Bid**" on envelop.

3. All pages of technical bid and financial bid shall be duly page-numbered and signed by the bidder at bottom.
4. Photo copies of all the documents shall be self-attested.
5. Conditional bids will not be accepted.
6. At any time prior to the opening of technical bids, the Institute may, for any reason, modify the tender document by suitable amendments/corrigendum through website of Institute. No separate communication shall be required to be sent to the prospective bidders.
7. The bidders will comply with the conditions mentioned in the tender document and accordingly clearly fill all the columns in both the formats (technical and financial), failing which, the Institute reserves the right to reject the same.
8. Incomplete filled-in tenders shall be summarily rejected.
9. The bids shall be opened as scheduled in the Notice Inviting Tender, in the presence of bidders or their authorized representatives, if any.
10. The financial bids of only technically qualified bidders shall be opened, as scheduled. No separate communication will be made in this regard.
11. In case there is public holiday on the scheduled date of opening of technical/financial bids, the same shall be opened on the next working day at the same time.
12. The bidders are expected to see the site to inspect repair work in question, which is required to be declared in the tender form.
13. No correspondence shall be made with these bidders, whose bids are rejected on the basis of technical or financial.

(E) GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT:

1. The estimated measurement of work in question is given merely as a rough guide. The quantity and items mentioned in the schedule may, therefore, vary, which will have to be accepted by the contractor in the offered rates. The payments shall be made to the agency as per actual measurement of work executed at site. The payment shall be made to the contractor on satisfactory completion of the work.
2. The payment shall be made to the contractor on satisfactory completion of the work.
3. Before using the material, the contractor shall get approval from the Engineer-in-charge / Institute and any change will require approval from the Institute.
4. After communication regarding award of work, the successful bidder shall, within 7 days, submit a non-judicial stamp of Rs. 100/- and sign an agreement with the Institute for the work, on the terms & conditions of the present tender.

5. The successful bidder shall also deposit requisite Performance Security @10% of contract value by online or Demand Draft or Fixed Deposit in the name of Registrar, LNIPE, Gwalior, which shall be valid at least for a period of 12 months.
6. EMD of unsuccessful bidders will be returned after finalization of tender. No interest shall be payable on such refund.
7. The Performance Security shall be refunded after successful completion of work up to the satisfaction of the Institute. No interest shall be payable on such refund.
8. The bidders shall quote their rates as per various terms and conditions given in the tender document under price bid, inclusive of all taxes, appropriate materials, labour, machinery, machines tools and plants and all appliances whatsoever are necessary for the complete execution of the work. Nothing extra shall be paid by Institute other than those quoted in the price bid.
9. All the required labour will be provided by the contractor and no minor shall be engaged at site. For all intents and purposes, the unskilled labour and such-like personnel provided by the contractor shall be the employees of the contractor, who shall be responsible to provide all admissible and/or fringe benefits to such personnel in the same manner as the contractor does to its other employees. The LNIPE shall not own any responsibility in any manner whatsoever for the same.
10. The competent authority of the Institute reserves right to accept the whole or any part of the tender and the contractor shall be bound to perform the same at the quoted rates.
11. The tender for the works shall remain open for acceptance for a period of 180 days from the date of opening of tenders.
12. The work shall be completed within 90 days from the date of signing agreement and intimation regarding commencement of work will be made by the contractor to the Institute.
13. A penalty @ Rs. 500/- per day will be imposed for delay and shall be deducted from the bill of the contractor, which shall not exceed 5% of the total cost. If any hurdle arises, the same may be intimated to the Registrar and accordingly, extension of time-period shall be made accordingly, if required.
14. The work shall be carried out as per CPWD specifications and up to the entire satisfaction of the Institute.
15. No waste/malva of any sort, including dismantled material, will be left at the work site or anywhere in the Institute campus and the contractor shall be responsible to remove and dispose it outside the campus at their own cost.
16. The contractor will be fully responsible for any type of loss to the Institute property during execution of work. If any damage is caused at the site or surroundings, the same shall be made good without any additional payment on this account.
17. The contractor shall raise the Bill as per actual work carried-out at site. Any item of work exceeding the quantity specified in this tender document shall require prior written permission of the Institute. The payment shall be made to the contractor on receipt of bills in duplicate and upon satisfaction of the Institute with respect to the entire work.
18. Necessary statutory deductions will be made from the Bill, as applicable from time to time.
19. Debarred/blacklisted agency/firm/ individual shall not be permitted to participate in the tendering process.
20. The sub-contracting shall not be allowed.
21. If the contractor fails to execute the awarded work or leaves half-way or fails to complete it to the entire satisfaction of the Institute, or commits breach of any of the terms and conditions of contract, then the Institute shall have right to forfeit bid security and/or

- performance security, as the case may be. The Institute shall also have the right to blacklist the contractor.
22. The contractor will not be entitled for any compensation due to enactment of any law / regulation etc. during the currency of the contract.
 23. All Taxes on materials or any element of this contract shall be payable by the contractor and the Institute will not entertain any such claim whatsoever in this respect. The contractor's rates shall cater to all such taxes.
 24. The Institute will deduct income tax and any other tax applicable, at source from all the payments made to the contractor under this contract, in accordance with the provisions of IT Act or any other law as applicable from time to time.
 25. The contractor shall be responsible for any damage to the equipment, machinery or system of the contractor's staff and the same will have to be made good at his risk and cost.
 26. When the works are carried out, the splashes and droppings from white washing, color washing, painting, etc. on walls, floor, windows etc shall be removed and the surface cleaned simultaneously with the completion of these items of work in the individual rooms.
 27. The contractor shall be fully responsible to observe the labour safety provisions.
 28. Action in case of bad work - If it shall appear to that any work has been executed with unsound, imperfect or unskilful workmanship or with materials of any inferior description the Engineer-in-Charge may rectify and re-execute the work or remove and replace with others, the material or articles complained of as the case maybe at the risk and expense in all respects of the contractor.
 29. Criteria for work award will ordinarily be the aggregated lowest rates quoted for all the items.
 30. The Institute reserves the right to ask the justification of quoted rates before finalization of agency.
 31. The contractor has to follow all electricity rules as amended from time to time and contractor shall be responsible for any mishap due to negligence on his part.
 32. In the event of any dispute between the Institute and contractor, it shall be resolved through mutual discussions between the parties. If it cannot be resolved through discussions, then an Arbitrator shall be appointed by the Vice Chancellor, LNIPE, Gwalior and the matter shall be referred to so appointed Arbitrator, whose decision shall be binding and final.
 33. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with tenders is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the bidders, who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.
 34. Any dispute arising out of the contract between the Institute and contractor, shall be subject to the territorial jurisdiction of Gwalior.
