**(A.) ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

1. The Bidders are required to submit the technical bid in the given format at ‘**Annexure A**’, along with the copies of following documents, duly signed/self-attested, with the technical bid for being declared to be eligible.
  - i. **EMD of Rs.69,000.00/- (Sixty Nine Thousand only)** in the form of Demand Draft in favor of **Registrar, LNIPE**, payable at Gwalior.
  - ii. Certificate of incorporation of the bidder (Copy of Certificate to be enclosed).
  - iii. **CGST/SGST Registration** (Certificates to be enclosed along with GST returns of the preceding one quarter.)
  - iv. Income Tax Permanent Account Number (**PAN**). (Copy of PAN card to be enclosed.)
  - v. The average annual financial turnover during the last three (3) years, ending 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022 (Assessment Year 2022-2023) should be at least 30 % of the estimated cost. (Furnish details and copies of “**Certificate of Turnover**” issued by a registered Chartered Accountant in the format prescribed at ‘**Annexure-B**’ along with the **Balance Sheets** of these **three years and Income Tax returns**).
2. Experience of having successfully completed works/similar works, “**REPAIR WORKS OF INDOOR & OUTDOOR SWIMMING POOL / REPAIR WORKS OF SWIMMING POOL**” (up to August 2023) in Government department(s)/PSU(s)/Organization(s)/Private Institute(s)/ Organization(s)/Educational Institute(s) by either of the following: -
  - (a). Three similar works completed each costing not less than the amount equal to 40% the estimated cost.
  - (b). Two similar works completed each costing not less than the amount equal to 50% the estimated cost.
  - (c). One similar work completed each costing not less than the amount equal to 80% the estimated cost.

[Enclose copies of only 3/2/1 work order(s) along with respective completion certificate(s)]
3. The Bidder(s) need to have its own Bank Account. (Details of Bank Account to be enclosed along with Account Statement of previous Quarter of on-going FY).
4. A declaration to the following effect is required to be submitted on the affidavit of Non-Judicial Stamp of Rs.100 /- that
  - (a) There is no pending criminal case before any Court of Law against the Proprietor/Firm/Partner on the bidder company.

- (b) The bidder has not defaulted from the payment of statutory dues like EPF, ESIC, GST, Income Tax etc. during the last three financial years.
- (c) The bidder is not blacklisted by any of the following:  
Government department(s), PSU(s), Organization(s), Private Institute(s), Educational Institute(s), Autonomous Institute(s) during the last three financial years.
- (d) No contract of the Bidder has been terminated before expiry of term till the end of submission date of this tender.

**(B.) FINANCIAL BID**

1. Financial Bid is required to be submitted in the format at '**Annexure-C**'.
2. Financial Bid of only technically qualified bidders will be opened at scheduled date & time, to be intimated separately to such bidders.
3. The rates quoted should be inclusive of all taxes. Nothing additional shall be payable during the period of contract.

**(C.) PROCEDURE FOR TENDER SUBMISSION**

1. Tenders are required to be submitted in a main sealed super scribed "Repair Works of Indoor and Outdoor Swimming Pool at LNIPE, Gwalior" and it has to be dropped in the Tender Box kept in the Office of Deputy Registrar (Estate) by 3:00 PM on 11<sup>th</sup> DEC 2023 . The same can also be sent by Speed-Post / registered post by clearly mentioning the above subject on Envelope and in such cases, it would be responsibility of the bidder that the same is reached to the Institute by 3:00 PM on 11<sup>th</sup> DEC 2023.
2. The main tender envelope should contain two sealed Envelopes as under: -

**Envelope No.1:** Containing duly filled in '**Technical Bid**' as per '**Annexure-A & Annexure-B**' along with required documents.

**Envelope No.2:** Containing duly filled in '**Financial Bid**' as per '**Annexure-C**' , Rate/Amount to be given in numerical and in words in the space provided for the purpose and write '**Financial Bid**' on the Envelope.

3. All pages of the Technical and Financial Bid shall be duly numbered and self-attested by the bidder.
4. No online bids will be accepted. All bids (both technical & financial) should be submitted in the physical form.
5. Xerox copies of all the submitted documents shall be self-attested.
6. Conditional Bids will not be accepted.
7. At any time prior to the opening of technical bids, the Institute may for any reason modify the tender document by suitable amendment/corrigendum(s) through website of the Institute. No separate communication will be required to be sent to prospective bidders.
8. The bidders will comply with the terms and conditions mentioned in the tender document and accordingly clearly fill all the columns in both the formats (Technical & Financial), failing which the Institute reserves the right to reject the same.
9. Incomplete filled-in tenders shall be rejected.

10. The bid shall be opened as scheduled in the Notice Inviting Tender (NIT), in the presence of bidders or their authorized representatives, if any.
11. The financial bids of only the technically qualified bidders shall be opened, as scheduled. No separate communication will be established in this regard.
12. In case, there is a Public Holiday on the scheduled date/day of opening the technical or financial bids, the same shall be opened on the next working day at the same time.
13. The bidders are expected to visit the site at the Institute to inspect the proposed work and be aware of the site conditions and scope of work, which is to be declared in the tender form.
14. No correspondence shall be established with those bidders, whose bids are rejected on technical or financial basis.

**(D.) GENERAL CONDITIONS OF THE CONTRACT**

1. The estimated measurement of repair work in question is given merely as a rough guide. The quantity and items mentioned in the schedule may, therefore, vary, which will have to be accepted by the contractor in the offered rates. The payments shall be made to the agency as per actual measurement of work executed at site.
2. The payment shall be made to the contractor on satisfactory completion of the work and the contractor shall prepare computerized bills using the program as approved by Engineer-in-charge as per prescribed format/pro-forma.
3. Before using the material, the contractor shall get approval from the Institute and any changes to the work with require approval from the Institute.
4. After communication regarding award of work, the successful bidder shall, within 7 days, submit a non-judicial stamp of Rs. 100/- and sign an agreement with the Institute for the work, on the terms & conditions of the present tender.
5. **The successful bidder shall also deposit requisite Performance Security @5% of contract value by Demand Draft or Fixed Deposit in the name of Registrar, LNIPE, Gwalior, which shall be valid at least for a period of Eighteen (18) months.**
6. EMD of unsuccessful bidders will be returned after finalization of tender. No interest shall be payable on such refund.
7. **The Performance Security @ 5% shall be refunded after 18 Months period after successful completion of work and satisfaction of the Institute. No interest shall be payable on such refund. Liability Defect Period /Warranty Period is of 1 Year for any Vessel Damages/Leaks and Pressure, Suction or Structure Leaks or any problem occurred and the Working Firm/Agency will visit the Filtration Plant(s) whenever a complaint is registered within 7 working days from the day of complaint registration for its resolved. The Agency will submit a SOP to the Institute after Complete Work is executed.**
8. The bidders shall quote their rates as per various terms and conditions given in the tender document under price bid, inclusive of all taxes, appropriate materials, labor, machinery, machines tools and plants and all appliances whatsoever are necessary for the complete execution of the work. Nothing extra shall be paid by Institute other than those quoted in the price bid, if scope of extra/lead or contingency work is not approved by the Vice-Chancellor of the Institute.

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9. All the required labor will be provided by the contractor only and no minor shall be engaged at site. For all intents and purposes, the unskilled labor and such-like personnel provided by the contractor shall be the employees of the contractor, who shall be responsible to provide all admissible and/or fringe benefits to such personnel in the same manner as the contractor does to its other employees. The LNIPE shall not own any responsibility in any manner whatsoever for the same and the Institute will not provide any labor [unskilled/UWA] for any scope of work whatsoever.
10. The competent authority of the Institute reserves right to accept the whole or any part of the tender and the contractor shall be bound to perform the same at the quoted rates.
11. The tender for the works shall remain open for acceptance for a period of **180 days** from the date of opening of tenders.
12. The work shall be completed within **90 days** from the date of agreement and intimation regarding commencement of work will be made by the contractor to the Institute.
13. **A penalty @ Rs. 500/- per day will be imposed for delay**, which shall be deducted from the bill of the contractor and the penalty so imposed **shall not exceed 5%** of the total cost. If any hurdle arises, the same may be intimated to the office of Registrar and accordingly, extension of time-period shall be made, if required.
14. The work shall be carried out as per CPWD specifications and up to the entire satisfaction of the Institute.
15. The dismantled material of the Sand Filter Model / Media will be the Institute sole property and is not subjected to be taken/handed over to/by the contractor and is not considered to be taken by contractor in any form(s) or state.
16. No waste/ debris of any sort other than dismantled material of the Sand Filter Model / Media, including dismantled material, will be left at the work site or anywhere in the Institute campus and the contractor shall be responsible to remove and dispose it outside the campus at their own cost.
17. The contractor will be fully responsible for any type of loss to the Institute property during execution of work. If any damage is caused at the site or surroundings, the same shall be made good within the quoted rates without any additional payments on this account.
18. The contractor shall raise the Bill as per actual work carried-out at site. Any item of work exceeding the quantity specified in this tender document shall require prior written permission of the Institute. The payment shall be made to the contractor on receipt of bills in duplicate and upon satisfaction of the Institute with respect to the entire work.
19. Necessary statutory deductions will be made from the Bill, as applicable from time to time.
20. Debarred/blacklisted agency/firm/ individual shall not be permitted to participate in the tendering process.
21. The sub-contracting shall not be allowed.
22. If the contractor fails to complete the work as per work order up to the satisfaction of the Institute, or commits breach of any of the terms and conditions of contract, then the Institute shall have right to forfeit EMD and/or performance security / guarantee, as the case may be. In addition, the Institute shall have the right to blacklist the contractor.

23. The contractor will not be entitled for any compensation due to enactment of any law / regulation etc. during the currency of the contract.
24. All Taxes on materials or any element of this contract shall be payable by the contractor and the Institute will not entertain any such claim whatsoever in this respect. The contractor's rates shall cater to all such taxes.
- 25. The Institute will deduct income tax and any other tax applicable, at source from all the payments made to the contractor under this contract, in accordance with the provisions of IT Act or any other law as applicable from time to time.**
26. The contractor shall be responsible for any damage to the equipment, machinery or system of the contractor's staff and the same will have to be made good at his risk and cost.
27. When the works are carried out, the splashes and droppings from white washing, color washing, painting, etc. on walls, floor, windows etc. shall be removed and the surface cleaned simultaneously with the completion of these items of work in the individual rooms.
28. The contractor shall be fully responsible to observe the labor safety provisions.
29. Action in case of bad work - If it shall appear to that any work has been executed with unsound, imperfect or unskillful workmanship or with materials of any inferior description the Engineer-in- Charge may rectify and re-execute the work or remove and replace with others, the material or articles complained of as the case maybe at the risk and expense in all respects of the contractor.
30. If the contractor fails to execute the awarded work or leaves half-way or fails to complete it to the entire satisfaction of the Institute, or commits breach of any of the terms and conditions of contract, then the Institute shall have right to forfeit bid security and/or performance security, as the case may be. The Institute shall also have the right to blacklist the contractor.
31. Criteria for work award will ordinarily be the aggregated lowest rates quoted for all the items.
32. The Institute reserves the right to ask the justification of quoted rates before finalization of agency.
33. The contractor has to follow all electricity rules as amended from time to time and contractor shall be responsible for any mishap due to negligence on his/labor part whatsoever.
34. In the event of any dispute between the Institute and contractor, it shall be resolved through mutual discussions between the parties. If it cannot be resolved through discussions, then an Arbitrator shall be appointed by the Vice Chancellor, LNIPE, Gwalior and the matter shall be referred to so appointed Arbitrator, whose decision shall be binding and final.
35. Canvassing whether directly or indirectly, in connection with tenders is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the bidders, who resort to canvassing will be liable to rejection.
36. Prior approval is required for any extra, lead or contingency work, if required.
37. Liability Defect Period /Warranty Period is of 3 Years for any Vessel Damages/Leaks and Pressure, Suction or Structure Leaks or any problem occurred and the Working Firm/Agency will visit the Filtration Plant(s) whenever a complaint is registered within 7 working days from the day of complaint registration for its resolve.

38. The agency will submit a SoP to the Institute after complete work is executed.
39. A declaration can be submitted by the bidder on its company's letter head for not being blacklisted/debarred/restrained by any institute work or tender, if accepted by the Institute or not.
40. Details to be furnished duly supported by figures in balance sheet/ profit & loss account for the last three financial years duly certified by the Chartered Accountant, as submitted by the applicant to the Income Tax Department. (Copies to be attached) with the bid document by the bidder, else the bid shall be considered incomplete.
41. An engineer for the supervision of the entire work shall be provided by the contractor only and his/her accommodation and mess shall not be provided by the Institute.
42. Any dispute arising from the contract between the Institute and the contractor shall be a subject of territorial jurisdiction of Gwalior.
43. If any discrepancy/error is found in the Hindi version, the English version will be applicable.
